All entries received shall be included in each draw of events in the Program. If a brigade at the time of the Championship is unable to enter a team in an event, the Brigade is requested to complete a scratching form prior to the event being held. Scratching forms will be available at the Association's office and are to be completed by an Officer or Coach of the entered brigade.

No Brigade will be permitted to compete in any Event unless the Brigade is affiliated with the Association on or before the 1st February. In the Under 14 Years Section - competitors must be 11 years old and be not older than 14 years prior to the 1st October, 2010. Any competitor who has turned 14 years on or after the 1st October 2010, is eligible to compete in the Under 14 Years events. In the Under 17 Years events, competitors must be under the age of 17 years as at the 1st October 2010.

CONDITIONS FOR BRIGADES TO ENTER MORE THAN ONE TEAM:

A Junior brigade must have a minimum of seven junior competitors to enter two teams, and eleven junior competitors if entering three teams at Junior State Championships.

The following conditions apply where more than one team is entered:

- (a) (i) A brigade may enter more than one team in either or both age groups.
If more than one team are entered in both age groups, they will be entered as Team 'A', Team 'B', Team 'C' etc. in the respective age groups.
- (ii) If a brigade enters more than one team in one age group (teams 'A', 'B', 'C' etc.) and only one team in the other age group – this team will be entered as Team 'A'.
- (b) Teams 'A', 'B', 'C' etc. will be treated as separate teams (or brigades), in the calculation of aggregate points, and for borrowing of competitors (Rule No. 7 as below).
- (c) Separate entry forms, entry fees and registration forms for all teams must be lodged with the Association in the form and manner from time to time prescribed.

RULE 7. BORROWING A COMPETITOR

Where a Brigade has less than the required number of competitors to complete a team at the Annual Championships, competitors may be borrowed as set out below:

Junior State Championships

- (a) One competitor in each age Section, may be borrowed from non-competing brigades subject to written approval of the Association and their brigade, and can compete in any position. All team members to compete in the uniform of the competing team. A non competing brigade is a brigade which is not competing at competitions or Championships during the current competition season.
- (b) On the day of a Championship, a brigade with insufficient numbers to compete in the 4 competitor events, may
 - (i) in Under 14 Years Section, borrow one competitor from competing brigades,
 - (ii) in Under 17 Years Section if the brigade has no Under 14 Years competitors, borrow one Under 14 Years competitor from competing brigades.These borrowed competitors to compete in own brigade uniform.
- (c) A borrowed Under 14 Years competitor may compete in the same event in both age sections.
- (d) The rules for borrowing also apply where a Brigade enters two or more Junior Teams.
