Monbulk Rescue Operation -

- Primary role, road rescue
- Is set up to assist in a variety of rescue types (domestic and industrial)
- Provides steep angle rope rescue
- Can provide a search camera with limited operations
- Is assisted by a Rescue Support vehicle
- Both vehicles are fitted with winches
- Can provide ample lighting at any scene
- Comes with expanded first aid kit and oxy-viva

Equipment and facilities include:

- Full set of hydraulic rescue gear
- A set of high pressure air bags (For lifting heavy weights)
- Search camera
- Two BA sets and spare cylinders
- Air tool set-up
- Demolition saw
- Chainsaw
- Full set of hand tools
- Steep angle rope rescue kit
- Extensive first aid kit and oxy viva and resuscitator
- Portable and vehicle mounted lighting
- Ropes and chains
- Electric road flares and fire extinguishers
- Stabilisation equipment
- Glass and sharps management kits

When to call a Rescue appliance? - Road accidents, domestic rescues, industrial rescues, where any rope rescue is required, to provide substantial scene lighting, when first aid equipment and/or first aiders are needed; at any incident in which people are trapped; at incidents where people need to be maneuvered up steep inclines

Training - The Rescue Appliance is available for training by other brigades and for Group training. Rescue accredited members of Monbulk Brigade are willing to help other brigades with particular training needs or advice or to demonstrate rescue techniques for particular situations.
