On the 5th March 2011, the Knox Fire Brigades Group will be conducting a volunteer fire brigade torchlight parade. The Knox Group conducts the torchlight every 2 years within the City of Knox.

The torchlight parade in Victoria is based on tradition. A large number of volunteer firefighters in uniform or turnout gear, carrying lighted open wicked lamps march through a town or city at night. A number of marching bands are interspersed within the parade.

It is a very spectacular sight.

The Knox Group of Fire Brigades 2011 march will finish at the Ferntree Gully football oval, Brenock Park Drive, where the Knox Festival will be in action. Traditionally, large crowds gather along the parade route and at the oval to greet the firefighters. Shortly after arrival at the football ground, there will be a spectacular fireworks display. All brigades and bands then return to Ferntree Gully Fire Station to continue the night's celebrations with friendly and welcoming CFA families.time to enjoy a meal and a drink too!

We anticipate that we will have 20 - 25 volunteer brigades (more than 250 volunteer firefighters) and 3 bands involved on the night.

We have ordered magnificent weather for this occasion!

The Knox Fire Brigades Group, covers the entire City of Knox which has a population of over 150,000 citizens. It comprises seven volunteer brigades and one staff / volunteer integrated brigade. Individual volunteer brigades in Knox have turnout statistics of 300-600 calls per year.
