A brief explanation of the Events conducted at Junior State Championships

Events conducted at Senior and Junior State Championships all involve the use of the basic firefighting equipment – hoses, hydrants, couplings and branches. Fire brigade competitions became popular in the late 1800's when brigades realised that fire brigade training could be more enjoyable if conducted in a competitive environment. Junior competitions were introduced in 1974.

A brief explanation of the events at Junior Championships is set out below:

Hydrant Race – Competitors run down the track carrying a fire hydrant, insert (“set”) the hydrant into a fire plug and finish over a finishing line. The event is conducted in heats with four competitors in each heat (2 in red lane, 2 in green lane). The final is conducted in fours with all times recorded.

Marshall, One Competitor – Competitor inserts (“sets”) hydrant into fire plug, connects first length of hose to hydrant, connects branch to second length of hose and joins second length to first, then comes back to hydrant, discards first length of hose and replaces with third length, couples this length into a dividing piece (“Y”) and connects two hoses to the two outlets of the “Y”, connects branch to end of fourth hose and finishes over finishing line.

Marshall, Two Competitors – Same as Marshall, One Competitor but two competitors compete and perform the tasks.

Y Coupling, Two Competitors – Competitors “set” hydrant into fire plug, couple first hose to hydrant and the other end into a dividing piece (“Y”), couple second and third hoses to the two outlets of “Y”, couple branches to the ends of hoses two and three and finish over finishing line.

Y Coupling, Four Competitors – Same as Y Coupling, Two Competitors but four competitors compete and perform the tasks.

Wet Hose, Two Competitors – Competitors “set” hydrant into fire plug, couple hose to hydrant, couple branch to other end of hose and strike disc with water. Run finishes when water strikes the disc.

Wet Hose Striking One Disc Twice, Four Competitors – Competitors “set” hydrant into fire plug, couple first hose to hydrant, couple branch to other end of hose and strike disc with water, disconnect first hose from hydrant, couple second hose, couple branch to other end of hose and strike disc with water from second hose. Run finishes when water hits disc from second hose.

Wet Hose Striking First & Second Disc, Four Competitors – Competitors “set” hydrant into fire plug, couple first hose to hydrant, couple branch to other end of hose and strike first disc with water, turn off hydrant, disconnect branch, couple second length of hose onto first length, couple branch to end of second hose and strike second disc with water. Run finishes when water strikes second disc.

Wet Hose Striking Second Disc, Four Competitors – Competitors set hydrant into fire plug, couple first length of hose to hydrant, couple first and second hoses together, couple branch to end of second hose and strike disc with water. Run finishes when water strikes disc.
