For information, below are items of interest approved from the VFBV Competition and Rules Committee for the information of Coaches, Competitors and Judges and Officials for the 2025/26 Competition season.

a) 2026 State Championship Entries – Stawell

Junior Championship Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 March 2026 Senior Championship Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March 2026

Entries are now open for the 2026 State Championships and will close on <u>Sunday 15th February 2026</u>, entries will once again be collected electronically. The brigade member responsible for completing the respective entry form should use the links below to register your team for the State Championships.

Following completion of the above forms a second form will be sent to you early next year which will collect the following information:

- Competitor names and CFA Member numbers (for all competitors)
- Parent/Guardian contact information for members under 18
- The events that each competitor is competing in

Entry fees: VFBV have waived the entry fees for the 2026 State Championships to encourage participation.

b) Member registration

New members: Brigades should commence the new member registration process ASAP to enable them to be registered to compete in both local competitions and the State Championships.

The new member registration process via the Volunteer Recruitment Hub takes longer than the old processes and needs to be started well in advance of the Championships to ensure that members are registered before competing. VFBV has no control over this process and CFA will not authorise competitors who have not completed this to compete at the State Championships.

c) Combined Teams and Borrowing Competitors from Non-Competing Brigades

All teams entering the State Championships (Junior and Senior) are reminded of the rules in relation to combined teams and borrowing competitors from non-competing brigades. The process as outlined in the Rule Book for *Rule 6. Combined Teams* and *Rule 7. Borrowing a Competitor* must be followed.

Any requests can be forwarded to championships@vfbv.com.au with permission from both brigades involved to be provided.

d) Number of competitors required to enter two or more teams in the State Championships Senior

Per Rule 1 (d) a minimum of 10 competitors is required to enter two teams in the State Championship. 'Team A' should be filled with 6 competitors with the remining competitors making up 'Team B'. Teams also need to adhere to *Rule 7. Borrowing a Competitor Senior State Championships* which indicates that a borrowed competitor can not be used in 'Team A' without the written approval of the Association.

Junior

Per Rule 3 (e) a minimum of seven competitors is required in the respective age group to enter two teams and a minimum of 11 competitors is required to enter three teams. Teams need to adhere to Rule 7. Borrowing a Competitor Junior State Championships which indicates that a borrowed competitor can not be used in 'Team A' where a brigade has two teams.

e) 2026 State Championship Judge and Official Nominations

Judge and Official nominations are now open and will close on <u>Sunday 15th February 2026</u>. To nominate as a judge or official for either or both of the 2026 State Championships, please complete the nomination form online: <u>tinyurl.com/2026-urban-judge</u>

Brigades are reminded of the requirement to nominate <u>two non-competing members</u> to act as a judge at each of the Championships. When a brigade has more than one Team competing, for every additional team, one additional <u>non-competing</u> member is required to be nominated as a judge or official. Failure to nominate the required number of judges may result in the brigade being disqualified from competing in a track event.

Female aggregate: Any team entering the Female Aggregate events at the Senior Championship is also required to provide <u>one additional non-competing member</u> to act as a judge or official at the Senior Championship.

First Aid: we are seeking additional First Aid officials for both weekends. If you are willing to assist, please complete the judge nomination form and email a copy of your first aid qualifications to championships@vfbv.com.au

Working with Children Clearance: All Judges and Officials for the State Championships are required to have a valid Working with Children Clearance and to have registered VFBV as an organisation that they are working with. Further details on how to apply for a Working with Children Clearance or to update a current Working with Children Clearance can be found on the VFBV website tinyurl.com/urban-champs

f) Updated Rule Book

A reminder that an updated rule book is available for download from the VFBV website tinyurl.com/urban-champs. The October 2025 updates includes changes to alteration to the number of competitors required to enter two teams at the Senior Championship; amendment to borrowing rules for the Senior Championship; alteration to the points allocations for the Senior Championship; insertion of new rules relating to the female section events; and insertion of new rules for the Y Coupling 6 Competitors event.

h) Female Section Events

Rules have been inserted in the rule book covering the Female aggregate events and borrowing. Brigades with female competitors should familiarise themselves with *Rule 7. Borrowing a Competitor – Senior State Championship* and *Rule 10A. Female Section Events*

i) Torchlight Procession

The Torchlight Procession will again take place on Saturday 28 March 2026 as part of the Urban Senior Championship. The Procession will commence at 2030 hours in Stawell.

Squad Size: the minimum number of marchers is 6 members plus a Commander and the maximum number of marchers is 15 plus a Commander. Any teams with more than the permitted maximum and less than the permitted minimum can enter, but will have points deducted from their scores.

Dress: the preferred dress is CFA Dress Uniform. If brigades are unable to outfit their squad in Dress Uniforms, CFA Workwear, brigade specific uniform with a CFA baseball cap or CFA summer dress uniform can be worn. All members of the squad must wear the same apparel.

LED Torches: LED torches will again be supplied by CFA for the Torchlight Procession. Please ensure that you accurately note the number of members requiring a torch on your entry form.
